ORDINANCE NO. 06-14-2004

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CEMETERY COMMISSION.

SECTION 1. A Cemetery Commission ("Commission") is hereby established to assume jurisdiction and management of Pioneer Cemeteries in Davis County, Iowa, pursuant to Section 331.325 of the Code of Iowa.

SECTION 2. The Commission shall consist of 15 persons, 1 from each township, residents of Davis County, Iowa, appointed by the Supervisors with the help of the planning committee as follows: five of the members shall be appointed for a term expiring July 1, 2007 ; five for a term expiring July 1, 2008 ; five for a term expiring July 1, 2009 ; their successors in all cases shall be appointed for a term of five years, and all appointments to fill vacancies shall be for the unexpired term.

SECTION 3. The Commission shall select a Chair Person, Vice Chair Person, Secretary, Treasurer and such other officers as the Commission shall deem necessary. The Commission will appoint an advisory committee of 3 persons in each township to establish a program of work for Pioneer Cemeteries.

SECTION 4. The Commission shall have authority to establish such rules and regulations governing its organization and procedure, as it shall deem necessary.

SECTION 5. The commission shall have all powers and duties relating to Pioneer Cemeteries, which may otherwise be exercised by the Township Trustees under the Code of Iowa. The Commission shall not have the authority to certify a tax levy.

SECTION 6. The Commission shall submit a proposed budget including the amount of available funds and proposed expenditures to the Davis County Auditor no later than January 1st of each year.

SECTION 7. The Commission shall receive no compensation for their services as such, but may be reimbursed for necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.

SECTION 8. Should any part of this ordinance be held invalid, the remaining part shall be servable and shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. All ordinances or parts of the ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 10. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after its passage and publication as required by law.
