The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, November 14, 2016, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Dale Taylor and Ron Bride present. Supervisor-elect Alan Yahnke was also present.

No public comments.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda, with the exception of cancellation of meeting with Randy Norman.

Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, November 7, 2016.

The Board met with Secondary Roads; usual blading and mowing continues; the Engineer reported on progress with the Apple Avenue bridge and presented contractor performance bond for Mulberry bridge project for signature by the Chairman. Public hearing was held on the 289th Trail and Harvest Avenue road closure and vacation. After hearing from a representative of Citizens Mutual Telephone concerning buried lines, Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to table any action until the County Attorney has examined the necessary paperwork.

The Board met with Anna Bruen, the new executive director of Pathfinders, who reviewed programs and thanked the Board for their support.

No action was taken on abatement of taxes on a parcel in Pulaski until the Assistant County Attorney has finished the required paperwork.

After discussion, Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to change committee assignments by adding South Central Behavioral Health Region to those meetings attended by Ron Bride and transferring attendance at 8th Judicial Court Services from Dale Taylor to Ron Bride. Also, Dale Taylor recommended removing Southeast Iowa Contracting Consortium from the list of committees due to the fact that it is inactive.

Ron Bride reported that he has spoken to a representative from the hospital concerning the county joining the hospital for HIPAA administration. It was determined to be not feasible.

Canvass of votes scheduled for 3:00 was postponed until 3:00 on Tuesday, November 15.

During committee reports, Matt Greiner reported concerning the Senior Center; Ron Bride reported concerning Emergency Services and South Central Behavioral Health Region; and Dale Taylor reported concerning Decategorization Committee payment of \$1500 to NEST and Pioneer Cemetery Board clean-up at Pansy Hill Cemetery.
