The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, February 12, 2018, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Ron Bride and Alan Yahnke present.

During public comments, Bloomfield Mayor Dan Wiegand gave the Board a letter thanking them for their letter the previous week and expressing the hope that the City and County can work together to achieve what is best for everyone.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, February 5, 2018.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported on a problem with frozen pipes in the jury room bathroom.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on several days of snow removal last week; presented State budget amendment #1-FY2018 for signature; reviewed crack sealing quotes for Floris Road; and updated on several bridge projects. Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve policy for improving a road from dirt to gravel, including responsibilities of landowners and the County. A copy is on file at Secondary Roads. Power Point presentation was made concerning FY19 budget and closed bridges.

The Board met with Sheriff Dave Davis and Chief Deputy Josh O'Dell, who informed the Board concerning federal standards and the Prison Rape Elimination Act, which will be very expensive to comply with but may jeopardize federal funding if not complied with. No action taken.

Assistant County Attorney Ashley Leyda Walkup told the Board that the lease agreement for the Pulaski Post Office has an incorrect legal description, so no action was taken.

The Board discussed ICAP loss control recommendations; no action taken.

During committee reports, Ron Bride reported on meetings of Soap Creek Watershed; Matt Greiner reported on meeting of Senior Citizens Committee.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the following claims to be paid:
