The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, March 5, 2018, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Ron Bride and Alan Yahnke present.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, February 26, 2018.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman and discussed uneven sidewalk in courtyard.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who updated the Board on bridge projects and reported on the results of 2017 bridge inspections, with 63 bridges having a lifespan of 5 years or less, but 22 of them have since been repaired or are under contract for repair. This total figure is down from 100 bridges listed two years ago. Final design for Matheny bridge and bridge inspection agreement with Calhoun-Burns were signed, as was DOT budget sheet.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve beer license for Davis County Agricultural Society.

Action on Schumacher Elevator modernization proposal was tabled until the Board members have studied it more thoroughly.

The Board met with Assessor Lois Heckethorn, who presented information about a grant through Iowa Senate File 500 which would facilitate information sharing between 911 systems and GIS systems. Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve application therefor.

The Board discussed with Auditor Linda Humphrey the responses to ICAP loss control recommendations.

During committee reports, Alan Yahnke reported on ADLM meeting; Ron Bride reported on Soap Creek Watershed meeting; and Matt Greiner reported on Fox River Watershed meeting and the Bloomfield City Council meeting concerning Streetscape.

At 1:00 p.m. the Board met with Roger Shindell of Carosh Compliance Solutions and department heads to receive information and ask questions about the HIPAA policy manual to be adopted by Davis County.
