The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, April 17, 2017, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Matt Greiner and Alan Yahnke present.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, April 10, 2017.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported on various work projects in the courthouse and courtyard.

The Board met with Secondary Roads; County Engineer Ryan Schock reported on progress on the Mulberry and Fig Avenue bridges; that the DOT has approved the five-year program; and that crack sealing work is proceeding on Beowulf road, fairgrounds road, and north of Drakesville.

Discussion was held concerning a rabies policy proposed by Davis County Public Health; no action taken.

The Board met with Sheriff Dave Davis concerning budget amendment to move money from the law center budget to the Sheriff's line item for utilities but Sheriff Davis stated that it had been determined that he did not need to amend.

Discussion was held concerning proposed contract with South Central Behavioral Health Region for employment of Community Services Director; no action taken.
