The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, May 14, 2018, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Ron Bride and Alan Yahnke present.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, May 7, 2018.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman and discussed general courthouse issues.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported that the Robin Boulevard bridge has been opened; the Oxen Trail project is done; bridge removal will begin this week for the Hougland box culvert; and bridge posting has been lowered from 14 tons to 6 tons on the Nuthatch Avenue bridge between 170th and 168th Streets.

The Board met with Linda Hougland, who spoke of concerns regarding speeding traffic on Jaguar Trail, which is a gravel road. The Board will have the Department of Transportation do a study of traffic and other issues regarding the possibility of a speed limit posting.

The Board met with Recorder Megan Clyman, who presented a proposal from Scantron-Harland Technologies for IT services, which would replace her as the courthouse IT person.

After discussion, Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to provide financial support to Bloomfield Senior Center to supplement the shortfall from Milestones Area Agency on Aging.

The Board discussed the possible need for a wind energy policy for the county and examined the Delaware County wind energy ordinance; no action taken.

During committee reports, Alan Yahnke reported on meeting of Pathfinders RC & D and Decategorization Executive Committee; and Matt Greiner reported on meetings of Bloomfield Senior Center and Workforce Development.
