The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, June 19, 2017, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Matt Greiner and Alan Yahnke present.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, June 12, 2017.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman and discussed LED bulbs and concrete work.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported that the rock program has been completed, with 41,670 tons of rock being hauled. Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to sign agreement with Dean Houglund for right-of-way.

The Board met with Rich Fetcho of the Davis County Trails Council, who requested that the County be a pass-through entity for future project funding; Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve same.

After discussion, Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to sign contract for purchase of new vote tabulating equipment.

After discussion, Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve use of the courtyard on June 27 through July 2 for Bible reading.

After discussion, Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve use of the courtyard by local bridal shop for event on July 15, 2017.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve installation of three 240-volt outlets in the courtyard for use of vendors.
