The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, July 17, 2017, with Members Matt Greiner and Alan Yahnke present.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, July 10, 2017.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported on various repairs in the courthouse and courtyard.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on bridge projects and presented Resolution to Vacate Excess Right-of-way on that portion of Lilac Avenue in Section 23-68-14, with Davis County retaining 65 feet perpendicular to the centerline south and east of Lilac Avenue between 165th Eastbound to 265th Westbound. The remainder of excess right-of way to be vacated and revert to landowners Cody and Megan Pickens and Roderick and Norma Pickens. Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve said Resolution, copy of which may be viewed in the Auditor's Office. Bill of Sale for bridge was signed, as were Hougland right-of-way papers.

The Board met with Sheriff Dave Davis concerning insurance invoice and correct budget item for payment thereof.

Discussion was held concerning the quarterly invoice of the water treatment inspector; will pay current invoice and hold further discussion concerning duties and payment.

The Board reviewed and discussed the County Conservation annual report; no action taken.

Discussion was held concerning County Farm property.

Ken Turner spoke to the Board about perceived problems with the Streetscape plan.
