The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, July 9, 2018, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Ron Bride and Alan Yahnke present.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, July 2, 2018.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who reported that four new trees were planted in the southeast corner of the courtyard.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who asked about the need for a 28E agreement with West Grove Township for maintainer parking. Patching will be done on Floris Road this week. Chairman Matt Greiner opened public hearing to establish Area Service "C" road on a portion of Oak Avenue. There being no public comments, Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to close the hearing. Alan Yahnke then made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve establishment of Area Service "C" road as proposed.

The Board met with Jen Cronin of Main Street, who requested use of the courtyard on August 7 between approximately 6:00 and 8:30 p.m. for "National Night Out" event; Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve same.
