The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, August 13, 2018, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Ron Bride and Alan Yahnke present.

The Board met with Karen Spurgeon, who requested use of the courtyard on September 5, 2018, for "Meet the Mustangs". Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve same.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, August 6, 2018.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who presented elevator electrical estimates and discussed more tree planting in the courtyard.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock and opened bids for Project #L-CO26(952056)-26. The low bid was received from BRS Construction at \$265,155.50; Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to accept the bid pending the Engineer's review of bid figures. The Engineer also updated on bridge projects and presented right-of-way papers for signature.

The Board met with Recorder Megan Clyman, who reported that it will cost an additional \$1,750 to incorporate Pioneer Cemetery information into the new county website.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve credit card purchase in excess of \$500 by Treasurer Mike Johnson.

After discussion, Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the updated Courthouse Security Plan and present it to the Sheriff and the Chief Judge for approval.

Assistant County Attorney Ashley Leyda Walkup told the Board that Assessor Lois Heckethorn has reviewed a wind energy ordinance from Delaware County which she feels is appropriate for Davis County, and they will prepare final wording for a Davis County ordinance.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.
