The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, December 2, 2019, with Chairman Alan Yahnke and Members Matt Greiner and Ron Bride present.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron and Betty Wilson spoke about A bridge on Cedar Avenue during public comments.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, November 25, 2019.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman and discussed problems with Christmas decorations in the courtyard; Randy also reported that someone had sprayed orange paint on the door of the Veterans Affairs building, which he has covered with new white paint.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported that crews have been working on crossroad pipes and box culvert repairs; Secondary Roads will agree to doing oil changes for Sheriff vehicles at \$65 per vehicle; Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve utility permits for Southern Iowa Electric on Robin Boulevard and Driftwood Boulevard.

After discussion, Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to close the courthouse for one hour from 12:00 to 1:00 p.m. on December 19 for the employee Christmas party.

Ron Bride explained revised language of 28E Agreement with South Central Behavioral Health Region concerning three additional board members; Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve same.

Approval of bid contract for County Farm timber harvest tabled until after payment has been received from successful bidder.

Discussion was held concerning Soap Creek Watershed and costs of inspecting and maintaining structures.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.
