The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in special session on Wednesday, March 18, 2020, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Matt Greiner and Alan Yahnke present.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda, with Chairman Ron Bride taking note that the agenda had been posted without fulfilling the 24 hour public notice requirement, due to the urgent nature of the meeting, as allowed per of Iowa Code Chapter 21.4(2)(a).

Discussion was held regarding the Iowa State Governor's State of Public Health Disaster Emergency regarding COVID – 19 (or Corona Virus).

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke that the Courthouse and other County facilities adhere to the Iowa State Governor Reynolds' Proclamation, by taking temporary measures which would restrict exposure and possible community spread of the virus. The county courthouse will remain open to the public, but will provide controlled and limited access to each individual office, and there will be signage posted at entrances, and on the county website, stating such.
