The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, August 17, 2020, with Chairman Ron Bride and Members Alan Yahnke and Matt Greiner present.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

During public comments, John Schroeder, representing the Davis County Development Corporation, presented the Board with a promotional marketing opportunity. No action was taken.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, August 10, 2020.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, and he reported on recent testing and installation of improvements relating to courthouse security.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock. At 9:00 Chairman Ron Bride opened the public hearing for vacation of a portion of Kelp Avenue and 305th Street. With no comments from the public, Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to close the hearing. Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve resolution to close and vacate the entire segment of public road (original and with modifications) commencing at the intersection of Kelp Avenue and Lilac Avenue and continuing South 0.484 miles (2,555 feet) and then turning West onto 305th Street for approximately 0.067 miles (350 feet) to the end of the road vacation.
