

ABSENTEE BALLOT REQUEST FORMS:

- are being mailed to every active registered voter in Iowa (not by the Auditor's Office).
- voters may receive multiple forms from many different political parties and organizations.
- ONLY ONE completed request form is necessary to be returned to the Davis County Auditor's Office.
- May also be requested by phone from the Davis County Auditor's Office (641-664-2101), OR printed from the Auditor's webpage of the Davis County website at www.daviscountyiowa.org.

Completed forms should be dropped off or mailed to the Davis County Auditor's Office, 100 Courthouse Square, Suite 2, Bloomfield, IA 52537, and must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 24, 2020.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS:

- The first day that they can be mailed to voters is October 5th, 2020.

Ballots to be mailed must be requested, in writing, no later than 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 24, 2020.

The Davis County Auditor's Office will pay postage for all completed ballots returned by mail.

The signed, and sealed affidavit envelope, containing your voted ballot, must be postmarked prior to midnight, Monday, November 2 (the day prior to the election), or may be delivered to the Davis County auditor's Office before the polls close at 9:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Absentee voting in person at the Davis County Auditor's Office will begin on Monday, October 5, 2020.

Voters may vote early during the regular office hours of 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. through Monday, November 2, 2020.

Voters will be required to wait outside the Auditor's Office until the voter in front of them has completed voting.
