<b>Saturday, January 2</b>	<b>Governor calls for Special Election. Candidate Filing Begins.</b> First day candidates may file nomination papers with the Secretary of State. <hr/>
<b>Monday, January 11</b>	<b>Worry-Free Postmark Date.</b> Mailed voter registration forms which are postmarked on or before today are considered on time to pre-register for the special election even if they are received after the Pre-Registration deadline of 5 p.m. on January 11. <hr/>
<b>Tuesday, January 12 5 pm</b>	<b>Candidate Filing Deadline.</b> Last day to file nomination papers with the Secretary of State. <hr/>
<b>Friday, January 15 5 p.m.</b>	<b>Voter Pre-Registration Deadline</b> The deadline to pre-register to vote for the special election is 5 p.m. This applies to registration in person (including registration at driver's license stations or agencies) or by mail.  <b>Exceptions:</b> Mailed registration forms postmarked on or before the worry-free postmark date, are considered on time even if they are received after 5 p.m. today.  After today, a person may register to vote at the Auditor's office and vote an absentee ballot using the same process for registering to vote on Election Day, EDR procedures.  <b>Last day to request an absentee ballot by mail.</b>  <b>Auditor's office must be open until 5 p.m.</b> <hr/>
<b>Saturday, January 23 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.</b>	<b>County Auditor's Office Open.</b> The county Auditor's Office must be open for at least eight hours for absentee voting and other election business.  <b>Auditor's office open 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.</b> <hr/>
<b>Monday, January 25</b>	<b>Last Day for Voters to Fix Incomplete Affidavits.</b> Voters have until 5 p.m. to fix incomplete affidavit envelopes.  <b>Absentee Ballot Postmark Deadline</b> Absentee Ballots postmarked by the day before the election and received by the time of the county canvass are considered on time to be counted.  <b>Absentee Ballot In-Person Deadline.</b> Last day to request and vote an absentee ballot in person at the county auditor's office.  <b>Auditor's office must be open until 5 p.m. if there are incomplete absentee ballots in need of correction.</b> <hr/>
