The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, July 11, 2016, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Dale Taylor and Ron Bride present.

During public comments, Ernie Bohi reported concerning a problem with his road, as did Nancy Clancy regarding 285th Street; Ken Turner asked if the Board has visited with any federal officials concerning the highway lane change.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Tuesday, July 5, 2016.

The Board met with Secondary Roads; bids were opened for the Apple Avenue bridge, and the low bid was \$279,204 from Iowa Bridge & Culvert. Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to accept the bid. Ron Bride requested that the Engineer find out what the DOT is using to kill teasel along the roads. The Engineer's Office will be closed Friday for the Davis County Fair. City of Pulaski is causing work to be done concerning wells located in county right of way. The Iowa DOT will be providing signs to be installed by the county at the Pickens curve on Lilac Avenue.

After discussion, Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve expenditure of an additional \$500 for railing change at the Veterans Affairs building.

Discussion of the custodial position was tabled.

Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to appoint the following persons to the Pioneer Cemetery Commission: Dale Taylor, Russell Forsythe, Virgil Cassill, JoAnn Cassill, Beverly Forsythe, Eileen Taylor, and Bob Stephenson.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve paying a \$100 filing fee and filing an application for a City water meter at the new jail site.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve the Sheriff's quarterly report

The Board met with Sheriff Dave Davis, who voiced concerns about overtime pay for deputies who have to transport or remain at the hospital with mental health clients due to a lack of beds. Meeting will be held on Tuesday with mental health region representatives, Jane Harris,

Sheriff Davis, Ron Bride, and possibly a representative from the hospital in an effort to resolve the matter.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve the following claims to be paid:
