The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, July 5, 2016, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Dale Taylor and Ron Bride present.

During public comments, Jane Harris gave an update on mental health pre-screening opportunities without committal; law enforcement education for crisis training; and substance abuse/mental health problems. Ken Turner and Nancy Clancy commented about highway lanes.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, June 27, 2016.

The Board met with Secondary Roads; plans have been approved by the DOT for the Apple Avenue bridge and bids will be accepted in the Auditor's Office through 4:00 p.m. on July 8, 2016, with opening on July 11. Discussion continued concerning sharing an Engineer with Van Buren County; no action taken. The Engineer reported that over 90,000 tons of rock have been hauled during the past fiscal year; Secondary Roads has used planks for sale at \$1 per board foot for an entire plank. Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to sign right-of-way papers for the Mulberry bridge. In response to question concerning Rural Basic payback, the Board stated that the required amount has been paid.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve the quarterly reports of the Auditor and the Recorder.

The Board met with Ben Grim and Nick Grim of Grim Farms, who requested installation of 4 or 5 gates at the County Farm; Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve the purchase of up to 6 gates to be paid for by the county. Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to allow expenditure of a maximum of \$4,200 for scrub tree and stump removal by Grims and possibly Funk's Tree Service.

Discussion of the custodial position was postponed until next week.

Report was provided that Linda Boatman has filed tax credits for the courthouse tower project. Dale Taylor reported that the Counties 4 Kids program is making cuts due to lack of funding; he also reported concerning SIEDA bus drops and pickups. Matt Greiner reported concerning Area XV and getting beds for mental health patients.
