The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, March 29, 2021, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Alan Yahnke and Ron Bride present.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to sign a Proclamation naming the month of April as Child Abuse Prevention Month, and to approve the corresponding decorations of a “Pinwheel Garden” along the sidewalks of the Courtyard.

During the time set aside for public comments, Karen Spurgeon questioned the Board about their past and current library contributions.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, March 22, 2021.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, who informed the Board that the sump pump in the basement required a replacement last week.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported various maintenance work being done around the county. Discussion was also held regarding the Drakesville “oval” and the intention of the County to vacate it, and “gift it” to the City of Drakesville. Robert Sampson, Mayor of Drakesville was also in attendance, and was included in the discussion.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve a resolution for a Crack Sealing project (#126) on the blacktop road South of Pulaski and to give the County Engineer permission to sign the contract electronically. This project will be funded with “Farm to Market” dollars and will cost \$464,495.64.

Tom Prosapio, construction manager for the Courthouse accessibility project, reviewed plans for the bid letting and funding for the next phase of the project.

All Board members reported on committee meetings attended.
