The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, May 23, 2016, with Chairman Matt Greiner and Members Dale Taylor and Ron Bride present.

Public comments were received from Doug Dixon, Mike Fitzgerald, Carol Taylor, and Ken Turner.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, May 16, 2016.

The Board met with Secondary Roads; work continues on 2 bridges; funding agreement for Cedar Avenue bridge replacement project was signed and the Floris bridge title sheet was signed. Impala Trail bridge work is finished. Mulberry Trail bridge design work begun for an October letting, with construction next year. After discussion, Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve a pay increase of 3% for three non-union employees: Ryan Schock, Bret Davis, and Dana Batterson.

Chairman Matt Greiner summarized the history of Streetscape and read from previous Board minutes of January 12, 2015, wherein report was made of request by Chris Ball and Ashley Noreuil for letters of support “now that the proposed plan of Highway 63 lane changes has been withdrawn and the highway would remain four lanes.” He voiced opinion that Main Street has become a special interest group that has the City Council going against the will of the people and the business owners; Dale Taylor agreed. Greiner also stated that he did not want to be part of enabling a special interest group coercing the Council into doing something the people do not want to happen. He asked the Board to do a Survey Monkey inquiring if the people want this project. Dale Taylor said yes, and Ron Bride said no.

Ron Bride stated that he hoped we were not now in a position where we can't move forward. Dale was concerned about Drakesville being used as a “by-pass” and problems that may arise because of a three-lane highway. Ron Bride would like to know if Board actions will cause the proposed handicap ramp and drainage repairs to be removed from the plan, and whether Board actions will change the decision about three lanes. He also stated that he is disappointed in the City's recent decision about three lanes. . Matt moved for a roll call vote to no longer support the Streetscape project and withdraw the pledge of \$30,000 toward the construction costs of drainage and access improvement to the historic Davis County Courthouse; second by Dale Taylor. Ayes: Matt Greiner and Dale Taylor. Nay: Ron Bride because of unanswered questions at this time. Motion approved.

The Board met with Lynn Davidson of Main Street, who requested use of the courtyard on June 26, 2016, for community worship services followed by a picnic dinner, as a part of Hairy Nation Days. Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to approve same.

The Board met with Teresa Roberts of Southeast Iowa Case Management, who presented 28E contract for renewal. The terms of the contract were the same except for new dates of service. Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to sign the contract.

Ron Bride made motion, seconded by Dale Taylor and carried unanimously, to re-appoint Bill Bride, Dean Bailey, and Marlynne Urban to the Veterans Affairs Commission for three-year terms beginning July 1, 2016.

The Board met with Kirby Moss, who recommended a change in the third party administrator for health insurance; no action taken pending receipt of more information.

During Committee Reports, Ron Bride reported on active interviewing for an assistant on the Crime Commission, and Assistant County Attorney Ashley Leyda Walkup reported on agreements reached concerning cemeteries on private land.

Dale Taylor made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the following claims to be paid:
